- Housing to meet all needs with minimal commuting time to the office

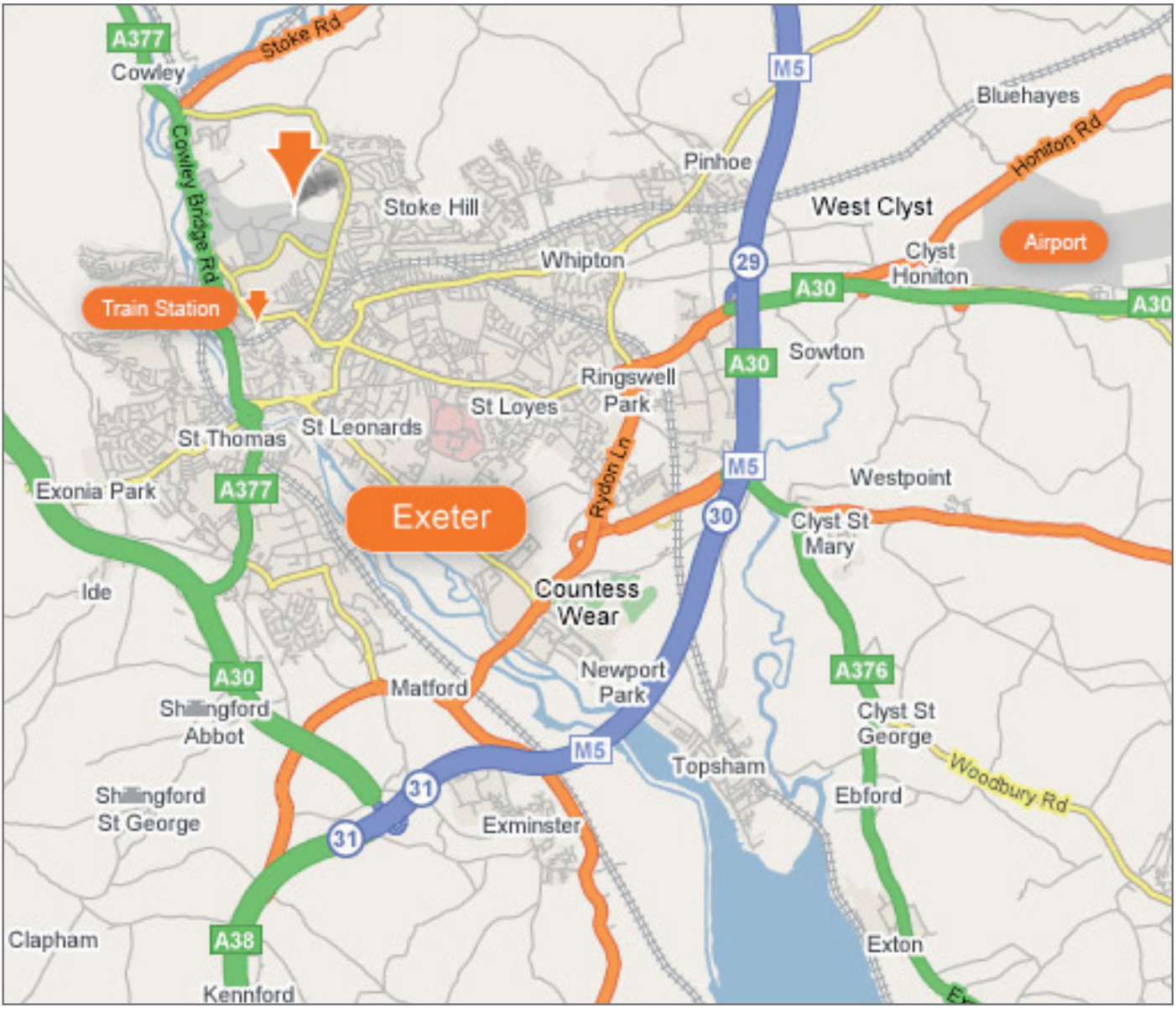
